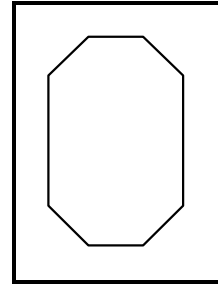
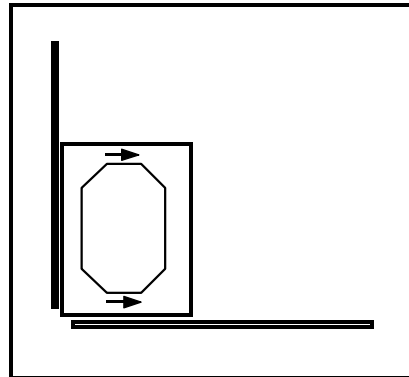


## 8-Sided Mats

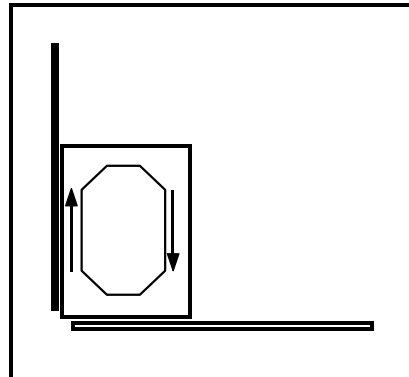
- 1) Draw the mat opening in pencil on the back of the mat.



- 2) Place the mat in the corner against the guides and close the hold down.
- 3) Set the stops for the top and bottom cuts using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 4) Make the top and bottom cuts. If cutting a double or inlaid mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.



- 5) Set the stops for the left and right cuts using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 6) Make the left and right cuts. If cutting a double or inlaid mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.



- 7) Place the mat at 45 degrees to the left using the 45 triangles. Hold in place with the bottom hold down.
- 8) Set the stops for the bottom cut using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 9) Make the cut, then rotate the mat to make each of the four corner cuts. If cutting a double or inlaid mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.
